June 4, 2024, Runoff Election

Due to a tie vote in the April 2<sup>nd</sup> race for Alderman Ward One between Robert Roskowske III and Herb Crosby, a runoff election has been called by the Clerk of the City of Winfield to be held on Tuesday, June 4, 2024. Pursuant to State Law, the official notice of election will be published in the Elsberry Democrat and the Troy Free Press the week of May 19<sup>th</sup>.

Absentee voting for the election will begin Tuesday, April 23, 2024. Registered voters of the City of Winfield who will be absent from their precinct on Election Day may come to Room 204 of the Lincoln County Courthouse on Main Street in Troy between the hours of 8 a.m. and 4:30 pm Monday through Friday to vote absentee. The county clerk's office will also be open from 8 a.m. to noon on Saturday, June 1<sup>st</sup> for absentee voting. The absentee voting period will end at 5 pm on Monday, June 3<sup>rd</sup> and all absentee ballots must be received in the County Clerk's Office by 7 pm on Election Day.

The polling place for the election will be Winfield City Hall located at 51 Harry's Way in Winfield. The polling place will be open from 6:00 am to 7:00 pm.
